## Terms and Conditions Poster Prizes - Neurons in Action 2025 Conference

§1

- 1. The Nencki Institute of Experimental Biology of the Polish Academy of Sciences hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer", organizes a competition for the best posters submitted for presentation at the Neurons in Action 2025 Conference hereinafter referred to as the "Conference".
- 2. The aim of the competition is to recognize authors whose posters excel in academic quality and presentation, outperforming their fellow participants.

§2

- 1. The competition is open to Neurons in Action 2025 Conference participants declared as Presenting Authors of posters accepted for presentation by Scientific Committee in accordance with the provisions of the Conference Terms and Conditions <a href="https://neuronsinaction.nencki.edu.pl/assets/Terms">https://neuronsinaction.nencki.edu.pl/assets/Terms</a> and conditions.pdf
- 2. The award winner can be only the author presenting at the conference as indicated in the Conference submission form.
- 3. The presenting author is expected to attend the Conference in person.
- 4. The presenting author confirm that will disclose any conflict of interest in poster and its presentation.
- 5. The presenting author confirms that all information within the abstract and poster is correct and has been approved by all co-authors.
- 6. To participate in the competition, the participant must accept *Terms and Conditions*Poster Prizes Neurons in Action 2025 by completing the form the content of which constitutes Annex 1 to these Terms and Conditions.

- 1. The Poster Session will take place on Wednesday, 28th May 2025 from 18:00–20:00 in CN Conference Hall at Nencki Institute of Experimental Biology of the Polish Academy of Sciences (3 Pasteur Street, 02-093 Warsaw, Poland).
- 2. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to the Conference program and undertakes to publish up-to-date information in this regard on the Conference website. In particular, the Organizer reserves the right to change the time schedule and the order of appearance.

§4

- 1. Prizes will be awarded to three(3) award winners in three(3) categories:
  - Junior PhD/Masters (PhD students in their first 2 years or Masters students)
  - Senior PhD (PhD students in their 3<sup>rd</sup> year and beyond)
  - Postdoctoral Researchers.
- 2. There are five categories of judging criteria:
  - 1) Scientific Content,
  - 2) Originality and Impact,
  - 3) Clarity of Visual Presentation,
  - 4) Oral Explanation,
  - 5) Engagement and Response to Questions.
- 3. Posters will be assessed by the Evaluation Committee according to the following *Poster Evaluation Criteria* judging criteria (each scored from 1 to 5 points):

- 1) Scientific Content:
  - 1.1) Is the research question clear and significant?
  - 1.2) Are the results robust and well interpreted?
- 2) Originality and Impact
  - 2.1) Does it have the potential to advance the field of neuroscience?
- 3) Clarity of Visual Presentation
  - 3.1) Is the poster layout logical and visually clear?
  - 3.2) Are figures, graphs, and text easy to read and interpret?
- 4) Oral Explanation
  - 4.1) Is the presenter clear, concise, and knowledgeable?
  - 4.2) Can they effectively explain the research to both specialists and non-specialists?
- 5) Engagement and Response to Questions
  - 5.1) Is the presenter enthusiastic and confident?
  - 5.2) Do they respond thoughtfully and accurately to questions?
- 4. The prize winner will be selected based on scores from the official Evaluation Committee: Mark Jeremy Hunt (Chair of the Evaluation Committee), Joanna Jędrzejewska-Szmek Łukasz Bijoch, Pawel Boguszewski, Jacek Wróbel, Nupur Ravindra Mahadeokar.
- 5. Following the official Evaluation Committee deliberations, an official report will be prepared.
- 6. The competition results will be announced on Friday, 30 May 2025, during the Closing Remarks & Awards ceremony, and will also be published on the Conference website after its conclusion.

**§**5

- 1. Prizes in total amount of 3000,00 PLN (3 prizes of 1000,00 PLN each) are sponsored by Maciej Czarnecki MMED, Centrum Medyczne NeuroProtect, (Klaudyny St. 16C, 01-684 Warsaw).
- 2. The prize winner of each of three (3) categories as mentioned in §4 point 1 will receive a prize of 1000,00 PLN (gross).
